

Requirements of Ford Motor Co. for Commercial Connection Rebates

Vehicles reported sold in the name of an individual will require documentation proving that the individual is an owner of an eligible commercial business. Additionally, purchases of Cab/Chassis do not need proof of business if reported in the BUSINESS NAME, but still require upfit receipts.

These are the acceptable proof of business documents as required by Ford Motor Company for the Commercial Connection Rebate:

- **Copies of "DBA" or assumed name documents
- **Sales Tax License
- **Crop/Livestock Insurance
- **Verifiable D & B Listing
- **Business License (not occupational license)
- **Commercial General/Public Liability Insurance (not commercial vehicle insurance)
- **Federal Land Use and/or Grant Subsidy Documents
- **Workman's Compensation Insurance
- **Articles of Incorporation
- **FIN Code
- **Verifiable US Dept. of Agriculture FSA Document w/farm # & owner
- **IRS Specialty form (schedule C or F)—other documentation highly recommended to avoid chargeback
- **Individual state authorized business/corporate websites (ie. Sunbiz in FL)

In order to get the upfit reimbursement you must have \$1200 in receipts for the following:
